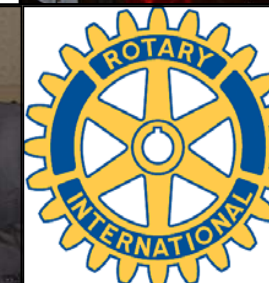

Two members of The Woodlands Rotary Club celebrated significant victories in Tuesday's March GOP primary contest, both besting rivals while securing sizeable majorities of the overall vote.

In the GOP primary contest for the 8th Congressional District, U.S. Rep. Kevin Brady, 53, overwhelmed three challengers to win 79 percent of the vote as of late Tuesday night. His opponents were pro audio visual systems designer Scott Baker, 34, of Willis, journalist Melecio Franco, 31, of Kingwood, and senior project engineer Tyler Russell, 28, of The Woodlands. He now faces Libertarian candidate Bruce West, of Cypress, and Montgomery County Democrat Kent Hargett for the 8th Congressional District seat in November.

Meanwhile, state Rep. Rob Eissler, R-The Woodlands, easily won a GOP primary challenge for the Texas House District 15 seat. He won 70 percent of the vote, defeating challenger Rob Thomas, of Magnolia. He now faces Libertarian Samuel Calkin in November.

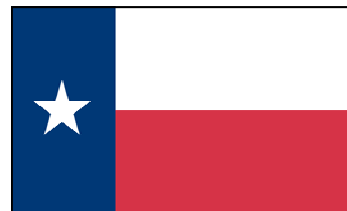
